BBBS OF Rockland County matches children facing adversity with rigorously screened adult volunteers in relationships designed to expand horizons and change the trajectory of their lives. Although, the children we serve come from all walks of life, they have one thing in common - they each need and want a mentor. Of the children in our program 91% live in a single-parent home, 66% live in poverty, and/or have an incarcerated family member. Looking to help? Please call (845) 634-2199 x4!

Big Brothers Big Sisters is the only mentoring program in Rockland County, established by Charter in 1984 as a direct result of the dissolution of the Rockland County Youth Bureau's Friends and Volunteers in Probation program. The mentoring partnership is based on the unique model of a one-to-one relationship and is in effect 365 days a year and can last up to 11 years targeting children and youth ages 7 – 18 years of age who need us most, including those living in single parent homes, growing up in poverty and coping with parental incarceration.

Making these matches and performing all the background work involved with child safety as our number one concern, is a testimonial to our mission of supporting and upholding positive youth development and advocating encouragement in areas of collective and communal support for Rockland's disadvantaged families, both in their health and, wellbeing.

The outcome of this partnership? The mentee's self-esteem increases and attitudes toward school and relationships with family and friends improve substantially.

Studies by independent research groups have shown that the Big Brothers Big Sister programs back up these assertions and that 67% of former Littles surveyed, agree that their Big played a role in their decision to attend college. This year, courtesy of the Rockland County Legislature, 4 of our youth graduated from our program at the age of 18 and have registered for college.

On another note, I am happy to report that BBBS alleviates some of the worry that families feel about camp attendance for their children. How? Well, we have a volunteer who comes into the office each week and sends out to her sphere of influence, appeal letters asking for camp sponsorships! Yes, Judie not only receives enormous amounts of support for camp attendances but she and her family provide matching funds so that many of our BBBS kids have a chance to experience summer camp!
